DIRECTIONS:

Aluminium and Stainless Steel: CYNDAN* ECONO 1301 should be diluted with up to 8 parts water. This solution should be applied to the surface working from the bottom up. Allow to penetrate for a few minutes then completely rinse with water. Assist any dirt to be removed with a brush.

Tiles, Porcelain, Fibreglass and Masonry: CYNDAN* ECONO 1301 can be used to remove dirt, rust, soap scum, calcium and mineral deposits. CYNDAN* ECONO 1301 should be diluted with up to 4 parts water. This solution should be sprayed or brushed on the surface. Allow a few minutes then rinse with water

NOTE: TESTING SHOULD TAKE PLACE ON ALL SURFACES PRIOR TO USE TO GAUGE THE REACTION.

SAFETY: Corrosive. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Wear protective clothing, gloves and eye protection.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting, give a glass of water and seek medical attention. Contact the Poisons Information Centre (13 11 26 Australia; 0800 764 766 New Zealand). If in eyes, hold eyelids open and flush with water for at least 15 minutes. If skin contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and rinse for 15 minutes with soap and water.
